Her artworks have twice been selected and displayed in Gandhi Darshan Art Gallery, Rajghat, New Delhi and Ayodhya Temple. She is invited as chief guest, special guest, speaker and judge in many events. She has inaugurated the 1st National Online Art Exhibition from Rajasthan. Her artworks are published in the cover page of national magazines, calendars, books, catalogues, newspapers and magazines.
